

To all participants, families, guardians, staff and loved ones:

At this time we will be scaling back all non-essential services to ensure the safety of our participants, staff and to be responsible stewards of our community and its limited resources. We have plans to continue all services that are essential such as 24 hour homes and those folks receiving similar 24 hour type services. If you are unsure how this will affect you, please reach out to the office directly at 307-362-6422. If you are able to keep your loved one home without being impacted please let us know. We will continue service as normal as soon as it is determined safe to do so.

Life Skills administration is taking this national emergency seriously and has adequate supplies and resources to continue delivering services for the near term. We are continually planning for long term solutions as experts finalize national and state wide responses. We will follow the guidance of state and local officials to ensure the safety of all those we serve.

We will continue to offer services at our day site to allow for participants to feel safe and have some sense of normalcy. Additionally this will give us the ability to monitor and assess our individuals needs in real time. We have already begun a thorough cleaning of all sites, and will continue to do this daily as to minimize the risk for those we provide services. We will limit outings during the day, opting to do games and enjoyable activities at the day site.
